Magic Poker is an exciting fun-filled variation of Stud Poker using one deck of cards and one 'Magic Poker' joker.

The Magic Poker Joker enables the player to reach a Five of a Kind winning hand. There's also the option to place a Bluff bet which pays 3 to 2 if the dealer does not open with an A/K or higher. The object of the game is to get a higher-ranking hand than the dealer.

How To Play

1. Before the dealer deals any cards, the player must place an Ante bet in the Ante box to initiate game participation. Each player will be dealt five cards, face down from the card shuffler, before the dealer deals himself five cards. The dealer's last card is dealt face up.
2. Players can then choose to place a bet on the Bet box equal to that of the Ante bet, or to "check" and not place a bet. In addition, they can also choose to place a bet on the Bluff box if they think that the dealer will not open with Ace or King.
3. Once all bets have been placed, the dealer will reveal their cards. The original Ante bet will be forfeited if the player decides to fold their hand.

4. If both the dealer and the player do not have a qualifying hand (A/K or higher), the Ante and Bet box will be a stand-off. If the player placed a bet on the Bluff bet, they will be paid out 3:2 on the Bluff bet only.
5. If the dealer does not open with a qualifying hand (A/K or higher) and the player has a valid hand, the Ante will be paid out 1:1 and the Bet will be a stand-off. If the player placed a bet on the Bluff bet, they will be paid out 3:2 on the Bluff bet.
6. If both the dealer and player have qualifying hands (A/K or higher) and the player beats the dealer with a higher ranking hand, the Ante will be paid out 1:1. The Bet will be paid out according to the odds on the Pay table. The player loses their Bluff bet.
7. If the dealer opens with a qualifying hand (A/K or higher) and beats the players hand, the player loses the Ante, Bet and Bluff bets.

Bluff Bet

The Bluff bet is optional and can be played if the player believes that the dealer will not open. To play the Bluff bet, the player must place a bet in the Bet box up to the value of the original Ante bet, in multiples of the table minimum.

When the dealer reveals their hand and does not hold an A/K or better, the player will be paid out 3 to 2 on the Bluff bet. If the dealer opens with an A/K, the player will forfeit the Bluff bet. The dealer will not open if the cards are less than an Ace or King.

Two Pairs	2 to 1
