NIU-NIU *Xtreme*

Niu-Niu Xtreme is a fun comparing card game played between the player and the dealer.

With its easy-to-understand rules and exciting gameplay, Niu-Niu Xtreme is a must-try for card game enthusiasts. Played with a standard deck of 52 cards the goal of the game is to achieve a higher hand than the dealer by dividing a five-card hand into a left hand with three cards and a right hand with two cards.

The value of the left hand must add up to a multiple of 10. The value of the right hand should be as high as possible.

When three cards form a multiple of 10 and the remaining two cards also form a multiple of 10, it is called a "Niu Niu". If all cards are face cards (J, Q, K) this is an "Ultimate Niu Niu"

The two-card hand is valued based on the rightmost digit of the sum of the card, e.g. a hand consisting of 3 and 4 is worth 7, but a hand consisting of 7 and 8 is worth 5 (the rightmost digit of the total, 15).

In the event of a tie, the hand with the highest-ranking card shall win.

In the event that the highest-ranking card does not break a tie, then the highest-ranking suit shall win. Spade is the highest-ranking suit, Heart the 2nd, Club the 3rd, and Diamond is the lowest-rank suit.

Face cards (J, Q, K) are worth 10 points. Aces are worth 1 point and all other cards are worth their face value.

Once a hand is divided, the comparing rules are applied to determine the winner.

How To Play

1. To participate a player must place an 'Ante' bet in the 'Ante' box, and place chips 3x the value of the 'Ante' bet in to the Change box (the change box holds chips in reserve, in the event that the dealer wins the round with a Niu 7 or higher).
2. Once bets have been placed, the game begins. The player and dealer shall each be dealt 5 cards face down.
3. The player must arrange their cards to make the best possible hand and the dealer does the same, with three cards in their left hand and two cards in their right hand.
4. The aim of the game utilising all five cards dealt, is to make a total of 0 with three of the cards dealt and a total of 0 with the two remaining cards. The player should aim for their left hand to add up to multiples of 10. The value of the right hand should be as high as possible and if higher than 10 the value is based on the rightmost digit of the sum of the card e.g. 15 is 5 points.
5. Once their hand is confirmed, the player must decide whether to continue with the game by placing a bet in the 'Bet' box, or to fold and forfeit their 'Ante' bet. When placing a 'Bet' wager the player must put down an amount equal to the value of the 'Ante' bet.
6. The player will then reveal their hand face up and the dealer will follow suit to determine the outcome of their hand. The player wins by obtaining a higher Niu hand than the Dealer or loses otherwise.
7. If a player has a higher-ranking hand to that of the dealer, then 'Ante' and 'Bet' wagers shall be settled according to the Pay Table.

8. If a player does not beat the dealer's hand they lose both their 'Ante' and 'Bet' wagers, however, if the dealer wins with Nui Niu the player's 'Bet' wager will lose at 3 to 1, and will lose at 2 to 1 if the Dealer wins with Nui 9, 8 or 7.

Niu-Niu Xtreme Progressive

To participate a player must place a chip on the bet sensor in addition to their 'Ante' bet at the start of each round of play.

Winning progressive bets are paid regardless of a player placing a 'Bet' wager, or if they decide to fold and forfeit their 'Ante' bet.

The player does not need to beat the dealer for a progressive bet to win.

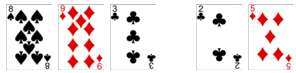

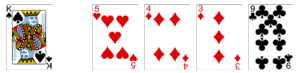

High Card - K Spades



If the player's cards and dealer's cards are the same point value, the highest suit of the highest card shall determine the winner:

1st ♠ Spade
3rd ♣ Club

2nd ♥ Heart
4th ♦ Diamond
